Evaluation of Pies

First Impression: Pre slice score – Includes consistency of crust or topping. After slice score – Based on degree of appropriate runniness, juiciness or firmness. Impression of first taste.

A Closer Look: Flavor – Strength and balance of flavor appropriate for type of pie; balance of sweet and/or tartness. Peripheral flavors should be balanced with main ingredient of pie. Mouthfeel: Appropriate consistency, i.e. thick, thin, smooth, creamy, chalky, mushy, runny, dry, sticky, etc. should be considered when appropriate. Crust – Flaky or mealy. Aftertaste – Pleasant or unpleasant.

Overall Impression: How impressive was it, how appealing and memorable.

Creativity: How much creativity went into this recipe.

Innovation: (Crisco Innovation entrants only) Combines traditional pie baking with new, innovative ideas and techniques. Crisco is a registered trademark of The J.M. Smucker Company

2012 APC Crisco Professional NPC Abbreviated Rules:

- This contest is open to legal residents of the 50 United States and D.C. except Arizona, Maryland, New Jersey, Tennessee, Vermont, 18 years of age or older. The contest is only open to professional chefs, baker, food writers, food home economists, students enrolled in a degree program at a cooking school, or any other person who regularly makes pies, baked goods or recipes for pay. The Contest entry may not have been sold in any restaurant or bakery. The Contest entry must be an original that was created by the person making the entry.
- Professional chefs entering pies must submit their entire recipe, including crust. Recipes must be original and never before published. Alcohol may not be used in recipes. Recipes must be submitted in English, attached to an e-mail (WORD files only), mailed or faxed on an 8 1/2" x11" piece of paper or submitted to apc@piecouncil.org. Please include your name and flavor category on the recipe.
- Entries and recipes must be received by 3/28/12, or entries by mail must be postmarked by 3/28/12 and received by 4/4/12.
- Only dessert pies may be entered in this contest and must include bottom and side crusts.
- One Grand Prize: One check for \$5000, a **Sears® Kenmore®** range and a **Crisco** Gift Basket. (Approximate Retail Value: \$6,100).
- One First Place and one Honorable Mention will be awarded in each of the twelve flavor categories listed. Twelve First Place Prizes: A check for \$200 and a **Crisco** Gift Basket (ARV: \$240 each); Twelve Honorable Mention Prizes: A **Crisco** Gift Basket (ARV: \$40 each).
- To choose the appropriate flavor category, choose the ingredient with the greatest quantity or strongest flavor to classify your pie.

**2012 Professional National Pie Championships (“NPC”)
 (“Contest”)
 OFFICIAL RULES**

ELIGIBILITY: This Contest is open to legal residents of the 50 United States and D.C. except Arizona, Maryland, New Jersey, Tennessee, Vermont, 18 years of age or older, and except employees of the Sponsors (and with respect to their designated pie category, each participating food company), their affiliated companies, parent, subsidiaries, website developers and administrators, and advertising and promotion agencies and their immediate families and members of their households. The Contest is open only to professional chefs, cooks, bakers, food writers, food home economists, students enrolled in a degree program at a cooking school, or any other person who regularly makes pies, baked goods or recipes for pay. The Contest entry may not have been sold in any restaurant or bakery. The Contest entry must be an original that was created by the person making the entry. The Contest entry must not have won previous NPC awards and must not infringe upon any other person’s rights, must not have been previously published, must not be waiting publication nor may it be submitted for publication consideration during the period of the Contest.

TO ENTER: There is a \$20 charge for each pie entered for members of the American Pie Council (“APC”) and a \$35 fee for nonmembers, payable by check or credit card (MasterCard or VISA). There are four ways to enter:

1. **By mail:** Complete and mail the entry form, recipe(s) and applicable entry fee(s) payment to: American Pie Council, P.O. Box 368, Lake Forest, IL 60045. Mail-in entries must be postmarked by March 28, 2012 and received by April 4, 2012.
2. **By e-mail:** Complete and mail the entry form as an attachment or include all information as text in the e-mail, recipe(s) and credit card payment for applicable entry fee(s) to the American Pie Council at apc@piecouncil.org. Alternatively, entry fee(s) payment may be sent by mail to: American Pie Council, P.O. Box 368, Lake Forest, IL 60045. E-mail entries must be received by 11:59 a.m. Eastern Time on March 28, 2012, and registration fee(s) must be received by April 4, 2012.
3. **By facsimile:** Complete and fax the entry form, recipe(s) and credit card payment for applicable entry fee(s) to the American Pie Council at 847-371-0199. Alternatively, entry fee(s) payment may be sent by mail to: American Pie Council, P.O. Box 368, Lake Forest, IL 60045. Faxed entries must be received by 11:59 a.m. Eastern Time on March 28, 2012, and registration fee(s) must be received by April 4, 2012.
4. **By Internet:** Complete the entry form available at www.piecouncil.org and submit recipe(s) and credit card payment for applicable entry fee(s). Alternatively, entry fee(s) payment may be sent by mail to: American Pie Council, P.O. Box 368, Lake Forest, IL 60045. E-mail entries must be received by 11:59 a.m. Eastern Time on March 28, 2012, and registration fee(s) must be received by April 4, 2012.

All entry forms/information and recipes whether mailed, e-mailed, faxed or entered on-line must be in English on a typed 8 ½” x 11” paper, an attached WORD file or typed electronically and

must include the name of entrant and category. Registration fee(s) sent under separate cover from original entry must include the name of the entrant and category.

CATEGORIES: Apple, **Crisco**® Classic Chocolate, **Crisco** Classic Cherry, **Crisco** Innovation, Citrus, Cream, Fruit/Berry, Nut, Peanut Butter, Mini Pie, Raisin and Open. Only dessert pies may be entered and must include a bottom and side crust. Entries in the **Crisco** Classic Chocolate, **Crisco** Classic Cherry and **Crisco** Innovation categories must use at least ½ cup of **Crisco** shortening or oil in the recipe. Entries in the Raisin category must contain at least one cup of raisins. Entries in the Mini Pie category must be 6 inches in diameter or less. Pies that include alcohol as an ingredient will not be accepted. All entries including the recipe submitted become property of the American Pie Council (“APC”) and The J.M. Smucker Company (“Sponsors”) and none will be returned.

JUDGING: All pies must be completely prepared by the entrant and delivered to the Caribe Royale, Orlando, FL between 8:00 and 9:00 A.M. on April 29, 2012. Entrants may prepare and bake their pies on-site at the Caribe Royale on Saturday, April 28, 2012 (subject to availability) during assigned baking times with a time limit of three hours. Potential winners (subject to eligibility verification) will be chosen on or about April 29, 2012 by APC judges whose decisions will be final and binding on all matters relating to this Contest. Each pie entry will be judged on the following criteria: *First Impression:* Pre slice score (Includes consistency of crust or topping), after slice score (based on degree of appropriate runniness, juiciness or firmness) and impression of first taste (up to 27 points). *A Closer Look:* Flavor (strength and balance of flavor appropriate for type of pie; balance of sweet and/or tartness. Peripheral flavors should be balanced with main ingredient of pie), Mouth Feel (appropriate consistency, i.e. thick, thin, smooth, creamy, chalky, mushy, runny, dry, sticky, etc.), Crust (flaky or mealy) and Aftertaste (pleasant or unpleasant) (up to 36 points). *Creativity:* (For all categories but **Crisco** Innovation) How creative is the pie (up to 9 points). *Innovation:* (Only for pies entered into the **Crisco** Innovation category) Combines traditional pie baking with new and innovative ideas and techniques (up to 9 points). *Overall Impression:* impressiveness (up to 18 points). All category points will be added to determine the winners. In the event of a tie the judges will re-judge the pies until a winner is decided. For safety reasons, all refrigerated pies will be tested to assure that the temperature does not exceed 45°F. Each recipe must include the U.S. standard measurements, complete preparation instructions, cooking time and temperatures, number of servings, size of pans and any special utensils or cookware.

PRIZES: One Grand Prize: A check for \$5,000, a **Sears**® **Kenmore**® Range and a **Crisco** gift basket. Approximate Retail Value (“ARV”): \$6,100. Twelve First Place Prizes: A check for \$200 and a **Crisco** gift basket. ARV: \$240. Twelve Honorable Mention Prizes: A **Crisco** gift basket. ARV: \$40. Total ARV of all Prizes: \$9,460.
